

# Essential Woodenware Set



Follow these step by step instructions to make your own woodenware!

What's the difference?

Many wood serving products are finished quickly by soaking in a plastic or petroleum derivative which only never hardens, or covered with a thick plastic film. These are hand finished exclusively using a slow curing, naturally derived oil that penetrates into the pores of the wood and hardens, protecting the wood beneath the surface. By controlling what you put on your woodenware, you get better control of what goes into your food AND they double as great gifts!
